



Existing bitmac stepped ramp in reasonable condition.



Mature tree obstructs path.



Main central path should be resurfaced to provide all weather surface.



Inappropriate bench is positioned within the scheduled monument site.



Felled tree across path could be repositioned along path.



Lack of edging has caused encroachment.



Opportunity to create DDA accessible, all-weather path as this is the flattest part of the site.



Felled Beech tree along path causing major obstruction.



Currently no entrance from north point of site off Roundhay Road next to all the bars and restaurants.



Current bollards not sufficient for deterring quad bikes.




Field garlic on site is struggling in shade of dense canopy.



Dead hedge works started at alternative entrance from Copgrove Road.



Poor and unwelcoming space for a main entrance. All entrances are unwelcoming and woods lack identity.

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Chicanes to be placed at entrances and to replace some bollards to prevent/slow down quad bikes and dirt bikes.



Potential for lecterns and welcome boards informing visitors of key features including flora, fauna and history, and of FOGW events in the wood.



Potential for carved wooden bench made by tree trunk already on site.



Use existing logs for games and sculptures to create a trail around the woods to entertain younger visitors.



Suggested use of GeoWeb around trees.

Transform old sub-station base to create picnic site and plant Hawthorn hedge to back.

Re-vegetate loop path after defining edges.

Biodiversity enhancements to rare species e.g. Field garlic.

Central spine footpath should be widened to 2m HopPath (or similar approved).

Potential to create scalloped edge woodland along Roundhay Road frontage.

Thin out wooded banking to encourage Wood Anemone and Celandine.



Paths to be converted to HopPath (or similar approved) to create parameter circuit paths.



Possible water retention method such as leaky dams.



Native wildflowers and bulbs planted to entrances to improve appearance and biodiversity.



Recycled timber logs placed along path to prevent encroachment.



Potential for new entrance with arch feature, connecting path surfaced with HopPath (or similar approved), and wildflowers and bulbs making it more colourful and biodiverse.

KEY

Halo thinning to be considered across the site to improve age diversity and light through the canopy to improve regeneration.


